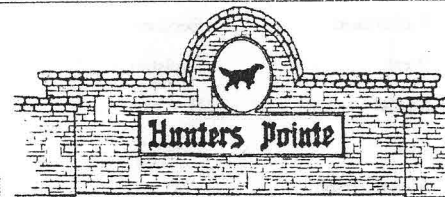

More Vandalism at the Pool

During the week of February 10, 1997, there was more vandalism at the pool. Someone destroyed the women's restroom and broke into the pump room. The Sheriff's Office investigated the crime and a report was filed. Please folks, we've all got to work together if we're ever going to stop this senseless destruction of property. Remember, it wasn't the Association's property that was destroyed, it was *your* property. Because of the repeated vandalism, the Association has decided on the following course of action. First, locks will be installed on the bathroom doors. Second, a street light will be erected in the area around the pool/playground/tennis courts. Third, an additional light and motion detectors will be installed at the pool house. Donald Nesmith and Lamar Reddick have agreed to purchase the streetlight. The Association will be responsible for getting the light installed and for the on-going operating costs. We can save a significant amount of the installation cost by doing the required trenching ourselves.
