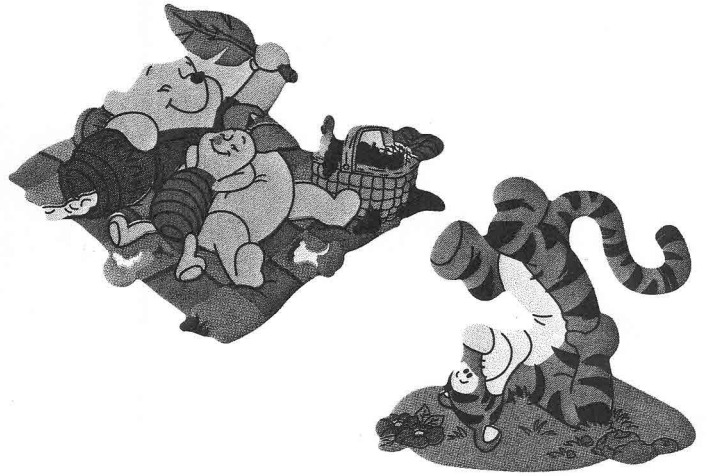
## Welcoming SPRING into Hunter's Pointe
